# FSS SUPPORTS THE MISSION: TRAIN WORLD CLASS PILOTS

The 14th Force Support Squadron is dedicated to supporting the mission at Columbus Air Force Base - Train World Class Pilots. Each FSS program and facility provides seamless and enriching experiences throughout their training. From educational materials and fitness initiatives to recreational activities and services, 14 FSS is committed to fostering a supportive environment for the future of the United States Air Force.



## PrintShop:

The PrintShop offers specialized tools that enhance the training process for student pilots. The PrintShop is now fully stocked with premade 30x40 inch cockpit posters for the T-6, T-1, and T-38 along with grab-and-go laminated checklists for \$1. The PrintShop spiral binds study materials such as manuals, guides, and booklets in addition to printing and mounting flight room ceiling tiles, and designing custom class patches.



## Library:

The Library is located within the Blaze Commons and has a wide selection of print and digital materials. Their collection includes a variety of leadership titles to promote airmanship and study materials such as CLEP, DSST, ASVAB, ACT, GRE, GMAT, as well as occupational certifications. In addition to physical materials, the Library holds access to free online resources, e-books, and more.



## Outdoor Recreation:

Outdoor Recreation's passion is to provide morale-boosting activities on and off base. CAFB has its very own Skeet and Trap Range, Archery Range, and Paintball Course. Whether you want to jump out of a plane during an DDR Tandem Skydiving Trip, explore the deep sea, scuba diving in Panama City, FL, or indulge in the streets of Historic Kentucky, DDR supports team-driven, recreational trips and activities to restore pilots' resiliency and get back to the mission - restored and ready for the fight!



## Fitness Center

# 5 WAYS THE YOUTH CENTER IS PREPPED AND READY FOR THE 24-25 SCHOOL YEAR!

School is back in action and Columbus Air Force Base Youth Programs is committed to setting students up for success! Whether you are an experienced back-to-school enthusiast or sending a child to school for the first time, the Youth Center has plenty of resources to help make this school year the best one yet!

**1** **After-School Programs with Transportation for School-age Youth**  
 School Age Care offers After-School Care for ages 5-12 with transportation from Columbus and Caledonia School Districts. Youth will have time allotted to complete their homework and get extra help, learn life skills, and participate in enrichment programs using the Boys and Girls Club of America and 4-H Curriculum. Programming is based on five core program areas: Character and Leadership, Education, Health and Wellness, Arts and Sports, and Recreation.

**2** **Teen-focused Programs**  
 The importance of teen involvement in youth centers can help increase academic performance and improve social-emotional well-being. The Youth Center is ESTATIC to announce BIG changes coming to the annex! The transformation will include a total Teen Room upgrade for teens ages 13-18. This renovation will allow teens their own space to learn, explore, and be themselves. Upgrades to the room include driving and flight simulators, working career space, the latest edition of popular gaming consoles, skeeball, a pool table, and a full snack bar.

**3** **Helping to Fulfill Graduation Requirements**  
 The Youth Center helps prepare high schoolers for post-grad life by providing ACT/SAT prep, hosting yearly career fairs, and leading college tours to include football games! Several programs such as Youth of the Year provide invaluable scholarship opportunities.

**4** **Parent Involvement**  
 Youth Programs pride itself on staying connected and acting as a resource for parents and guardians. Quarterly Parent Advisory Board meetings are offered where parents can provide input, ask questions, and have a voice in their children's care. This also aids in networking with other parents and the school liaison.

**5** **School Liaison Office**  
 The School Liaison Program directs resources and develops community partnerships to help military-connected children thrive academically, socially, and emotionally - regardless of duty station, deployments, or transition status. The program is vital to readiness, resilience, and retention. The school liaison office stands to bridge the gap between the school and education programs at the surrounding schools.

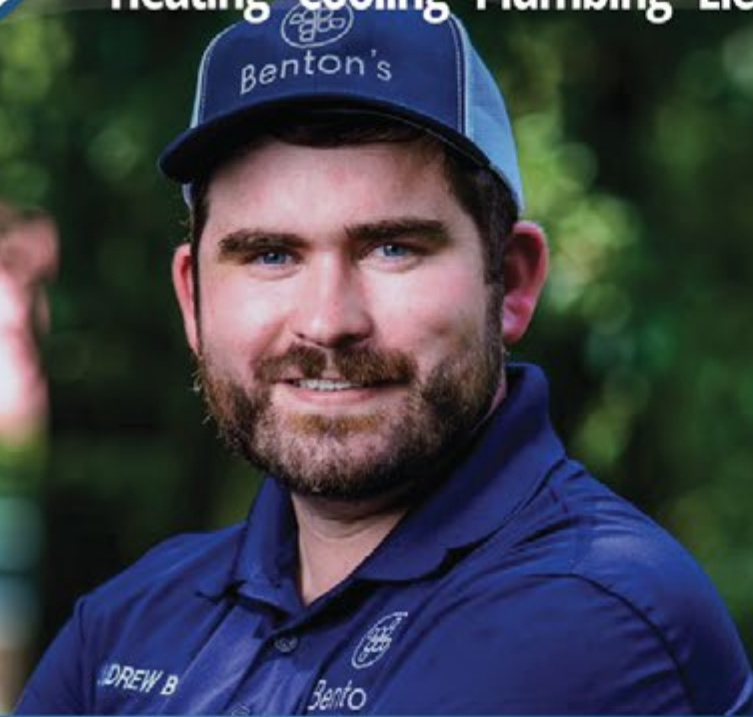
