## WHY ARE SLPM'S NEEDED?

- ▶ School transition and deployment support is an Air Force readiness and retention issue.
- ▶ The Air Force benefits from having Airman who can focus on the duties, whether ashore or deployed.
- ▶ Air Force families move their children an average of every 2.9 years. Children of military personnel attend up to *nine* different schools by graduation.
- ▶ Military families are reluctant to disrupt high school youth in their senior year.
- ▶ Deployments can impact the educational outcomes of children. Many families decide to "seperate geographically" to keep children in their current school.
